The Stream, Gary Lane, Bosnia, 1993, 7 mins Produced as part of the Bosnian War Protest Film Project, this striking short film is based on a true refugee story.

The Lake, Gary Lane, Germany, 1993, 7 mins

An idealistic Jewish woman is a tourist guide in a concentration camp. The film uses simple and elegant resolutions through metaphor for the problem of historical identity.

The Bridge, Gary Lane, Bosnia, 1994, 7 mins

Based on the story of the lovers trying to meet at a bridge in Sarajevo guarded by the two opposing sniper forces.

Zombietown, Mark Hawker, Scotland/Belgrade, 1995, 26 mins Punk underground expose of Belgrade. Zombietown is a dynamic elaboration of underground youth culture.

INTERVAL: 10 mins

Industry and Sex Doll, Kazuhiro Shirao, Japan 1994, 38 mins Inspired by taking a night drive through an industrial area & the terrifying discovery of a vending machine for inflatable sex-dolls. The film starts in the public space of the city, moves into the private space of a room & climaxes phantasmogorically in an industrial environment.

INTERVAL: 20 mins

I Was Hamlet, Dominik Barbier, France, 1993, 74 mins

An experimental biography of theatre director, Heiner Muller, which enlarges the canvas to discuss Greek mythology, monuments, the city, history & death. A highly innovative production utilising new technologies to integrate the exploration of themes & concepts. Solvieg Dommartien is an unexpected interviewee.
